

Eph 1:10-11

10. That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:

11. In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who *worketh all things after the counsel* [the pre-earth counsel and the plan of salvation] *of his own will*:
