










Without using the Standard of Scripture as your philosophy of life, and your world view, the chance of being wrong is near 100%





Hugh Nibley once came to class excitedly and announced that he found two mistakes in The Book of Mormon. He said 'twice it states that mankind is carnal, sensual, and devilish.' Brother Nibley then said that the prophetic authors forgot to include one more adjatiave in the list:

"STUPID"



There are two world or global views addressed in the Scriptures and embraced by the masses today. The first is 'Secular' which is the most popular and prevalent, and the second is the eternal or 'Scriptural' that reflect the vision of prophets, holy men and God.

When it comes to the subject of 'Religion' and 'Politics' the Standard Works of scripture should be the source one relies for answers. Likewise, the scriptures should be the eschatological source to understand the events (spiritual, temporal and political) that lead up to the Second Coming. The political and religious nature of men and nations can be seen in history and therefore predicted in the present and the future because 'the nature and constitution of man hasn't changed since the beginning' (TPJS) and the "natural man is an enemy to God and always will be.."

The advent of Christ and His millennial reign comes about because of the conflict between these two world views. The spiritual survival of the individual based in faith and the *A-moral* secular and political environment.


The 'Second Coming' initiates the eventual amalgamation of 'religion and politics'. The separation of church and state will eventually come to an end as the spiritual world view comes into focus as patterned in 4th Nephi.

The Second Advent of Christ will combine civil and religious life together for those of one heart and one mind. Even with this common knowledge of the millennium; the historical and political narrative of the scriptures are completely overlooked. Scriptural history records that the influence of political policies and platforms will become a major cause of the spiritual decline that escorts the events and desolations of the last days.

Governments will either protect our faith, families, and freedoms or they will seek to restrict and eliminate them.

In the minds of many members and non-members, there is a total 'disconnect' between scripture and life in general, especially political philosophy. (TWV) The secular or temporal concerns usually supersede the scriptural and spiritual anxieties in all faiths. It is thought by many that the historical political content found throughout scripture is predominantly just that: historical content rather than insights provided by God through prophetic inspiration.

The 'disconnect' from scripture is because the Secular World View is embraced by the masses. The secular view either ignores or seeks to change the moral injunctions found in scripture that pertain to a temporal environment. This is done by negating God's commands that are based on eternal concepts that pertain to the plan of salvation and happiness.

These spiritual concepts are rejected because

scriptural doctrines and principles project

eternal investments

found in scripture, rather than

earthly enjoyments.

For example one must ask the terrible questions that might separate the secular from scriptural world views, such as:

Is abortion condoned by God and scripture?

Are alternate lifestyles such as adultery, same sex relationships or fornication acceptable?

What about socialism in the political arena?

Is the cancel culture or silencing opposing ideas congruent with the nature of God?

True Freedom of thought and the difference between a real education and social or secular manipulation, requires two mental attributes. These are intimately connected to a mental and spiritual free agency and the ability to recognize eternal truths, they are:

Discrimination Distinction

One must be able to Discriminate between values: Good, Better and Best.

And be able to Distinguish between morals: good or bad, right or wrong, truth or falsehood.

Discrimination & Distinction

The Secular World View embraces relativism and humanistic teachings which eliminate both of these attributes through intellectual manipulation. This Satanic world view seeks to blur or even blind our minds to essential and eternal truths, until there is no distinction between right and wrong, or between commandments of God and desires of man.

Discrimination & Distinction

When there is no Discrimination or Distinction of eternal truths all that is left is money and power.

The goal of money and power is always more power and more money.


Discrimination & Distinction

A "standard" is necessary in all disciplines and all learning.

The *morality* of those with a *Secular World View* will always determine their theology.

The morality of those with a *Scriptural World View* and theology is determined by the Standard.

As George Barna has shown in his research and surveys over the past 6 years, a person's worldview, be it secular or scriptural, is most often in place by the age of 13.

The research showed that there are 6 key questions that should be understood or known by the youth before their world view is set

1. Who am I?

To be made in the image of God means we are set apart from the rest of creation, "a little lower than the angels," as in Psalm 8. Grasping this scriptural perspective, of being a child of God helps youth see their essential worth in a new light.

2. How does the media influence me?

Given the amount of media teens are exposed to by the time they turn 18, educators (at home and in church) must also help students comprehend (1) how it influences them, (2) what their vulnerabilities are and (3) how to discern the world-views behind the media.

3. What is my identity?

When youth see their physical selves as God's masterpieces (see Eph. 2:10), they see themselves as God sees them. Ultimately this allows them to pursue their place and purpose in society and creation, having an others-centered orientation and developing a genuine charity and love for the poor and those in need.

4. Where did I come from?

Teachers must play a key role in demonstrating how faith and science are not mutually exclusive. Acknowledging that God created the heavens and the earth, and us in His image, Religious educators can reinforce and encourage students' faith through the *purpose of creation*.

5. Where does my creativity come from? (Why am I here)

Parents and teaches should expose their youth to the origin of communication and the arts—particularly as talents are provided by God. By understanding that creativity comes from God, they should be encouraged to use their gifts and talents in the work of God.

6. How should I view others?

Self-worth crumbles when we view others or ourselves as less than we are in God's eyes. To help youth understand the devastating effects of passive-aggressive, sexual and mean-spirited social media, and the significance of not viewing others as children of God, spiritual teachers must give them a framework to be loving, kind, gentle, forgiving and others-centered—nurturing them to be much-needed culture-change agents in their generation.


Religious doubt, by its very nature, leads to both a stronger belief in something and unbelief in something else. Therefore, the question is not whether doubt will lead to unbelief, but which beliefs will be strengthened and which beliefs will be rejected.

Doubt can lead to a strengthening of one's beliefs that Jesus is the Christ and the only way to the Father. Today the accepted theology is a pluralistic view of the road to heaven eliminating differences and doctrines and the negating of scriptural perspectives and morals.

Doubt is not the enemy. It is inevitable. And it is important to understand that humans cannot live in the state of doubt forever. They find a way to resolve the doubt by accepting an answer that satisfies the doubt or question. That answer, be it true or false, will either strengthen the core belief or reject it for another one. They naturally seek sources to help them process and resolve doubts. They turn first to sources that are seen as safe and knowledgeable in the area.

In todays political and religious environment, the only thing that can hold the mental and moral integrity and a spiritual testimony together, that can prepare an individual for Life and for Death is:

Their Faith in God, and a Knowledge of Truth.

When faith and truth, right and wrong, good and bad are eroded away by the wrong world view, or education, only skepticism and doubt is left. When this happens the Secular World View replaces Gods laws and eternal truths with mans opinions, traditions, fears and emotions. This is Satan's subtle way to establish the false truths of a secular world and social acceptance that lead away from God.

Today, *faith and religion*, in a very subtle way, are the headliners on the political stage and platforms, as well as in the courts.

The line between the separation of church and state blurs as governments and 'political correct' venues seek to control moral and religious thought. This they do through public (government controlled) education at all levels. Political controlled morals blind the minds of youth, turning religious immorality, sins and transgressions into civil rights that extinguish the freedom of religious thought and belief.

The institutions of learning, from kindergarten to college, now have the power to determine what religious morals may or may not be accepted. This Secular World View is found in the teachings and arguments of Korihor, in Alma Chapter Thirty.

Korihor's Secular World View in Alma 30

17. And many more such things did he say unto them, telling them that there could be no atonement made for the sins of men, but every man fared in this life according to the management of the creature; therefore every man prospered according to his genius, and that every man conquered according to his strength; and whatsoever a man did was no crime.

(Foundational Thoughts that create a Secular World View)

18. And thus he did preach unto them, *leading away the hearts of many*, causing them to lift up their heads in their wickedness, yea, leading away many women, and also men, to commit whoredoms—telling them that when a man was dead, that was the end thereof.

Nephi warns of the sign of apostasy among the saints of the Latter-days who will voice that same thought in the words:


'all is well in Zion yea, Zion prospereth'

Isa 45:18.



Every 24 hours planet earth makes a 360 degree spin at 1,000 mph






At the same time the earth is moving through space around the sun at the speed of 67,000 mph.

Like Superman, that is faster than a bullet, and 87 times faster than the speed of sound. On a day you do nothing but set on your porch, you have traveled 1.6 million miles through space. Now that's a miracle.






Even when your doing nothing your moving pretty fast



Our solar system is traveling through space in one arm of the rotating Milky Way galaxy which is rotating at a speed of 448,000 mph. Even at this rate it would take 230 million years to make one rotation.

So here is our speed through space within our galaxy: 1,000 mph rotation + 67,000 mph around the sun and 448,000 mph in the galaxy that's at the slow speed of 516,000 mph we are moving as we speak. That's 8600 miles every minute.



Let's not forget; the whole galaxy is moving in a circular movement through space at the speed of 252,000 mph






Because of the the movement through space, Our Milky Way galaxy will collide with the Andromeda galaxy in about 4 Billion years.

All combined, that's makes a total speed of 12,800 miles per minute or 213.3 miles per second that we are moving through space toward our death.



One of Gods greatest miracles is the conception, growth and birth of a physical body for a spirit to inhabit and animate. A body that will be unique and unlike any other person, yet, each created in the 'image of God'.

One needs only to look into the face of a baby to see the miracle of life, when two cells divide and multiply 47.2 trillion times. These cells contain instructions within them for some to turn into different organs for different purposes to sustain life, from its inside to the outside. From brain to bone, blood to skin, eyes to teeth and lungs to provide the oxygen needed to every cell. This miracle of cell division takes place so that in nine months a person is born that looks like a combination of the parents and ancestors and is now able to live on a planet traveling through space 12,800 miles per minute or 213.3 miles per second Psalms 139.

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Each time you look in the mirror you look at a miracle an individual that cannot be duplicated and never will be duplicated. Your birth is proof of the genus of God that explodes into you and only you. A body to house a spirit that when combined has the potential to become a God.

Mother Teresa said that 'a nation that will kill their posterity (created in the image of God) has lost its soul'.



If your personal genetic code was written out in long hand it would be a 3 billion word tome. The Bible alone has 783,137 words. The genetic code of each individual would be a library the size of 4000 printed Bibles. Each person that ever lived or is now living on the earth would have their own genetic library that would different from every other person. The Secular World View would call that 'chance'



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
