The first principles of man are self-existent with God. God himself, finding he was in the midst of spirits and glory,¹¹ because he was more intelligent,¹² saw proper to institute laws whereby the rest could have a privilege to advance like himself.¹³ The relationship we have with God places us in a situation to advance in knowledge.¹⁴ He has power to institute laws to instruct the weaker intelligences,¹⁵ that they may be exalted with himself,¹⁶ so that they might have one glory upon another,¹⁷ and all that knowledge, power, glory,¹⁸ and intelligence, which is requisite in order to save them in the world of spirits.^{19,b}
