

INTRODUCTION

This bibliography deals with the concept of "name" in antiquity as well as the new or 'hidden name' that one would receive as part of ascension and initiation ceremonies.

The bibliography is divided into two areas or classifications, the first being, General, and the second being, Egyptian. The first section is broad and contains bibliographic works from many cultures and time periods. The second section deals exclusively with the idea of naming and the giving of second names in Egyptian mythology and religion.

The sources I found most valuable were the Theological Dictionary of the New Testament as well as the Dictionary of New Testament Theology. There were no articles that I could find, that dealt with the new or hidden name in Egyptian mythology. Most of the references were found by reading, and checking indexes, for passing references pertaining to the 'hidden name'. Religion I as well as Religion II were checked by CARS, and yielded nothing, as did the Subject Index for periodicals. Two articles were found on renaming in the Index to Festschriften in Jewish Studies. The major source of information that was used in the paper, of which this bibliography is part, was collected from Egyptian texts, such as the Pyramid Texts, the Book of the Dead, and others.
